

AURIS veterans support forensic content audit

This report lists every occurrence of veterans support wording found in the project, the category it falls into, and whether the file was changed or intentionally left unchanged. AURIS works worldwide, so UK specific support routes are labelled UK specific and readers elsewhere are pointed to services in their own country.

Findings

F01 C1 Changed

Veterans' Gateway recommended as a live national support route

File: src/lib/articles.ts

Replaced with a signpost to the veterans support page, which holds the GOV.UK veterans support directory as the current UK route.

F02 C1 Changed

Veterans' Gateway named in policy paper support block

File: src/routes/research.identity-in-global-transition-policy.tsx

Support block now signposts the centralised veterans support page instead of the closed service.

F03 C2 Intentionally unchanged

Veterans helpline 0808 802 1212

File: src/lib/veterans-support.ts

Verified as still live and answered 24 hours a day. Kept in one canonical module, labelled UK only, and allowlisted in the audit.

F04 C3 Added

Repeated support paragraphs across articles and research pages

File: src/components/support-signpost.tsx

Single signpost component replaces duplicated wording so support copy is maintained in one place.

F05 C3 Added

No single authoritative support destination

File: src/routes/veterans-support.tsx

Created /veterans-support as the one page holding verified support routes, and added it to the sitemap.

F06 C4 Intentionally unchanged

UK specific research claims and study citations

File: src/routes/research.index.tsx

Left unchanged because the underlying interviews, document review and policy analysis are genuinely UK specific.

F07 C5 Changed

Site description framed AURIS as a national initiative

File: src/routes/__root.tsx

Reworded to a research initiative exploring identity transition worldwide.

F08 C5 Changed

Organization schema areaServed set to United Kingdom

File: src/routes/index.tsx

areaServed changed to Worldwide, with UK retained only as the operating location.

F09 C6 Added

No wording for readers outside the UK

File: src/lib/veterans-support.ts

Added neutral international wording pointing to local emergency, healthcare or veteran services. No international service or URL invented.

F10 C1 Added

Risk of the closed service returning to the codebase

File: scripts/audit-veterans-support.mjs

Automated audit fails the release gate on any new Veterans' Gateway wording, unverified helpline sighting or dead support link.

Validation

scripts/audit-veterans-support.mjs runs in the release gate and on a schedule. It fails on any new mention of the closed national service, any unverified helpline sighting, any removal of the verified helpline, and any dead support link. Newly introduced matches are reported against a stored baseline.
